### Fr. Bing's Easter Message 2024

On Easter morning, Mary Magdalene, Peter, and John the Beloved ran eagerly toward the tomb, hoping to find your body. But the tomb was empty; they saw the clothes that wrapped your body and head. Mary and Peter have not yet learned the new way of seeing: *Seeing with the eyes of LOVE*. But the disciple Jesus loved, John, arrived first in the tomb and went in: *He saw and believed*.

Easter is the time to level up from our narrow-mindedness to a widened horizon, from a hardened heart to a humble and contrite heart. The sins and the disobedience of man led to the crucifixion and death, the ultimate sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. He died on the cross to open the gates of heaven for us, to save us from our sins. Because Holy Week was *encountering Christ quietly*, Easter should be *encountering Christ joyfully*. Let the peace and joy of the risen Christ be with us all, and wear that joy in our hearts with a smile on our faces.

**Easter is when Jesus is alive!** I see the risen Jesus in every person and me as well. To make Easter always alive in our hearts is to be mindful of the Risen Lord. Let the Easter spirit triumph by opening the tomb of Good Friday and see the empty tomb with the eyes of LOVE.

What do we need this Easter Season?

- 1. Comfort With the much disturbing news, fake news, and the eroding social and moral fabric of our society and especially the family Jesus is inviting us to come to Him for COMFORT. Come to me, all who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light. (Mt. 11:28)
- 2. Hope Jesus died and rose from the dead; He conquered death. Let us never lose HOPE, knowing the light is at the end of every dark tunnel. *Be still and know that I am God. (Ps. 46:11)*
- 3. Renewal Some of us may feel that our energy is low and our batteries drained: *Create in me a clean heart, O God. And renew in me a steadfast spirit. (Ps. 51:10)*
- 4. Inspiration Look at the Lord; He suffered so much and died for us. Let His suffering and death inspire us, knowing its Redemptive effect. *Do not fear: I am with you; do not be anxious: I am your God. I will strengthen you; I will help you. (Is. 41:10)*
- 5. Serenity Prayer: God grants me the **serenity** to accept the things I cannot change, the courage to change things I can, and the wisdom to know the difference.
- 6. Truth Who is the TRUTH? Jesus says: I am the way, the **truth**, and the life. No one comes to the FATHER except through me. (Jn. 14:6)

As part of this year's Eucharistic Revival join Dr. Ron Snyder in a four-part series titled: "He is not past; He is present now".


Together we will explore one of the greatest minds of the Church - St. John Henry Newman in his understanding of The Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. All are welcome!

#### A Happy Ending Isn't the Whole Story

"Is there a happy ending?"

When my kids were young, we never made it past the first whiff of any narrative tension before I got this question. As soon as whatever princess or furry woodland animal who was the hero of the story got into any small scrape, they wanted that reassurance, "Is there a happy ending?"

I can't say I blame them. Don't we all feel that way sometimes? We enter into a relationship with someone or some situation, and we just want to protect ourselves. We want to know it's not going to go badly — or, if it does, that we will be able to come back from it. It's a human instinct, a reflex. Our inclination to protect ourselves makes it so that we sometimes want to press fast-forward on the bad stuff and skip straight ahead to the happily-ever-after.

Easter is the ultimate happy ending. It's the day of miracles. The day when all the stones roll away and all the sins are forgiven. It's the day that puts everything right.

But if we learned anything from this week — from the Passion and death of the Lord — it's that we can't press fast-forward on the hardships of life. That tension, that loss, that fear — it's crucial, isn't it? As Catholics, we are who we are because of Easter. But Easter doesn't happen without Good Friday.

So, does the story of salvation have a happy ending? We know it does. But we also remember that the ending isn't all that matters.








