1st Reading: <u>Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14</u>

Around 200 years before Jesus, Greek conquerors tried to make Jews abandon their religion. The Book of Daniel offered the Jews visions of their triumph and the final victory of their God. This vision of the heavenly court includes the presence of a mysterious figure whose name is translated as "a Son of man." This figure is given everlasting dominion over the earth and all peoples.

2nd Reading: 2 Peter 1:16-19

The remarkable experience of the Transfiguration is evoked to give Christians under persecution a reason to hope.

Gospel: Matthew 17:1-9

Moses and Elijah represent the Torah and the prophets; Jesus transfigured between them is revealed as the fulfillment of the Scriptures. Peter is presented as a typical human who wants the "good stuff" to last forever. At times in our life we may have a profound experiences in which we really feel/see the grace, love and peace of God; like Peter we may want to stay put, "set-up camp" and not want to do anything else or venture out of our comfort zone. This reading reminds us that these moments of grace are meant to strengthen us as we continue our journey through life. It's these experiences, which strengthen us to be Christ for someone else.
